Safety and Security

Our institute has kept safety and security concerns on priority by taking note of the following common college security issues:

Contact Details: To ease concern among everyone from teachers and staff to parents, we implement communication systems with the help of keeping the contacts records of students, faculty, and parents/Guardians to ensure that everyone receives the necessary information in the case of an emergency.

24/7 Surveillance:

- ❖ Our premises have hi-tech or high-value CCTV equipment on site which protect criminal damage, theft, vandalism, eve-teasing.
- ❖ A fire extinguisher is established to extinguish or control small fires, often in emergency situations.

Medical Emergency:

- ❖ First Aid: First aid is provided to the needy by Pharm D faculty in the First Aid Room.
- During medical emergencies, students are sent to the Multi-specialty Hospital accompanied by faculty.

Clearance and Security Check for Visitors and Staff:

- Similar to the idea of enclosing the actual buildings, we screen visitors for safety before clearing them to enter the college premises.
- This screening process before entering the premises to be sure that visitors do not pose any security threat.



Educating Everyone

❖ Students along with faculty and staff are trained on being security conscious. Making everyone alert, including students, to increase the probability that potential threats will be promptly reported. In this training, students are encouraged to speak up if they ever see or hear anything suspicious or concerning.

Access Control:

We have given students access cards (ID) that allow them entry into the necessary buildings but restrict access for others. Other related access control measuresinclude security cameras, headcounts of how many people are where, and simultaneous management of multiple locations.








Counseling


- ❖ The Mentor-Mentee system is effectively implemented in the college and a group is allotted a respective faculty member.
