C. Vasundara for making the program successful.



SUMMARY

We discussed about the travelling measures to avoid the infection.

Efforts should be made to help pharmacists and practitioners prepare for the upcoming year and how they can best position themselves for success. Pharmacists will continue to become more involved in-patient care, technology, and emergency preparedness.

We report that the experiences of the COVID-19 pandemic may still impact the health care landscape, medication use, Travelling, and the pharmacy profession over the next 5 years.

"This year's reflects the ongoing challenges associated with COVID-19, and the related opportunities for pharmacy professionals to continue to enhance their leadership and advance their practices in service to their patients and communities from the bedside to the home and all points throughout the continuum of care,"

Pharmacists' roles in emergency preparedness will continue to grow, including in the development of plans for future disasters or emergencies such as pandemic outbreaks. Within health systems, pharmacists will also need to create contingency staffing plans in response to significant health-system patient volume shifts.

Pharmacists must be allowed to take on greater roles in providing vaccinations, administering COVID-19 tests, and organizing and overseeing mass vaccination programs. Pharmacy leaders and organizations should continue to advocate for the expansion of these responsibilities, according to the report.

The expansion and development of technology were accelerated by the pandemic, increasing the ability of health systems to use digital health solutions and artificial intelligence to optimize medication management. Pharmacists will likely be key leaders in the effort to streamline digital health solutions and integrate them with current workflows. Pharmacists will also manage chronic conditions from remotely generated health data, according to the report.


Despite this accelerated technological development, a lack of technological access and literacy also negatively impacted underserved populations during the pandemic. Some technologies, such as voice-assisted technology, are being used in health care to improve information accessibility, and pharmacy leaders can advocate for equitable access to digital tools to ensure that underserved populations benefit from technological advances, according to the report.





SUMMARY

Student-faculty relationships are the most crucial connection within a collegiate community. Like any relationship, those between faculty members and students require nurturing.

Advisors who know their students' talents and understand their faculty colleagues' gifts for helping the student grow to occupy a unique position where they can facilitate strong relationships between advisees and their professors.

When advisors help facilitate conversations between students and faculty members, they help the institution as a whole. When students feel connected to the campus community, they are more often retained and excel academically, creating a winning situation for everyone.

A sense of connection with teachers helps students feel like they belong at the institution. Advisors can aid in building this connection by helping students understand that they should get to know their professors, if only so that faculty can teach them better.

Faculty members who understand the learning needs and interests of their students can appropriately tailor assignments, expectations, and conversations.

Faculty also can suggest a host of effective study strategies ranging from note-taking skills to the best ways to critically read a particular text. Often students do not take advantage of faculty knowledge of study skills, even though faculty have studied long hours in their fields in order to get the positions they currently hold.

These conversations can also be helpful to students who believe they have solidified their

academic interests, as role modeling, references, and research opportunities can arise from

these relationships. Through these educational conversations, faculty can challenge students to

excel academically and help students reach their potentials.

We can help these conversations occur not only by pointing out their tangible benefits, but also

by explaining that most faculty members enjoy working one-on-one with students. Advisors

can remind students who feel negatively towards interacting with a particular teacher that

people behave differently in groups than in one-on-one situations. A clear explanation that

relationships start as one-on-one efforts can help students see that faculty are approachable and

often are willing mentors in the learning process.

Advisors should tell students that the most fruitful conversations with faculty center on

learning, rather than grades. To build a good relationship with a faculty member, a student

should demonstrate that learning, rather than arguing for a better grade, is central to the

discussion. In addition, students who have educational conversations with faculty tend to reap

the most benefit from the interaction. When they help their students ask faculty well-crafted

questions, advisors can help faculty and students connect.

Good faculty-student relationships begin with conversations. There are several conversation

starters that advisors can use in order to ease the student into making a connection with faculty

members. It is noted that students who receive faculty mentoring have higher grades.

Advisors better prepare students for the workforce when they encourage their advisees to see

their professors as supervisors who evaluate their work rather than someone responsible for

student performance on assignments.

Advisors can help students and faculty invest in each other for both student and institutional

success. Academic advisors can help students learn strategies to better access faculty



SUMMARY

The ICT in Education curriculum broadly attempts to equip teachers with ICT competencies to strengthen their own professional capacities and to effectively use ICT tools and devices in their teaching- learning. Teacher will also be trained to manage the ICT environment in the school and function as a local coordinator for organising capacity building programmes. The curriculum therefore is rolled out as a series of short courses, spanning the six strands and ensuring together the basic, intermediate and advanced levels of competence. Three induction and twenty refresher courses leading to a diploma in ICT in Education is proposed. Induction courses are to be conducted in face-to-face mode whereas State (SCERTs/ SIEs) may choose to conduct the refreshers in face to face or in online mode





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

Seymour Paper, The Children's Machine: Rethinking School in The Age Of The Computer. The principles and practices of teaching are both an art and a science. Education influences our youngest generations, it inspires children to think differently and it develops critical thinking in young, influenceable minds. In school, children acquire language, science and mathematical skills that they can use later on in life. Education has a recurring impact, long after children become adults. The principles of teaching are constantly evolving; collaborative learning, flipped learning and deep learning are all a mainstay of the modern classroom. If teaching is the act of encouraging learning activities through discovery and acquired knowledge, pedagogy is the method of teaching, both as an academic subject or theoretical concept. Within pedagogy, there are four core learning profiles: Auditory learners benefit from listening to the information presented to them in class. They learn orally from both listening to instruction from the teacher and audio recordings. Visual learners prefer to see information in order to visualise the relationship between ideas and concepts to understand them. Reading and writing learners prefer to take on information by reading texts. These learners can further absorb information by condensing and rephrasing it.

The workshop has given lot of novel techniques to be followed by the teacher in reaching the student effectively and efficiently.
