Overview of the FDP:

Providing affordable medicines is one of the goal of sustainable development. Large amount of population around the globe is far from getting the medical treatment at reasonable price. This may be due to the cost involved in the whole process of drug discovery and development. The total cost of the drug discovery process can be reduced by developing appropriate technologies used as tools in the preclinical and clinical phases of drug discovery process. For this, the in-depth knowledge about the subject and decision-making is very important. These skills can be imparted to the students during the undergraduate and postgraduate programs and very much desirable to include in the curriculum of pharmacy and medicinal chemistry education. The recommendations of New Education Policy-2020 (NEP 2020) also indicate the skills to be developed in the students has to be taught in the classroom with emphasis on the practical knowledge on the subject. This is possible only if the teacher is having knowledge in the current practices of the subject in the industry. With this background, this FDP is planned to give an overall idea of modern methods of drug discovery process to the participants. So that, they can transfer the knowledge to the students effectively. This FDP will be emphasized the relevance of medicinal chemistry in the pharmacy curriculum, its role in the evolution of pharmacy, and its paradigm shift to pharmaceutical care, as well as its history and intellectual domains. As some educators are already engaged in this endeavor. However, the future research/reviews should address the scope of medicinal chemistry in the pharmacy curriculum with appropriate drug class examples. The components of drug design and discovery contribute to the pharmacy student's foundational knowledge base and will have a tremendous impact in advancing the professional leadership in the pharmaceutical and health care sectors.

Objectives of the FDP:

- To enhance the understanding of the process of making a molecule from laboratory to market
- To empower the participants to take the contemporary topics of medicinal chemistry and sub-subjects to the class room

Topics to be covered:

This FDP will focus on the effective teaching and learning of various principles of modern drug discovery process. The main topics are:

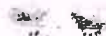

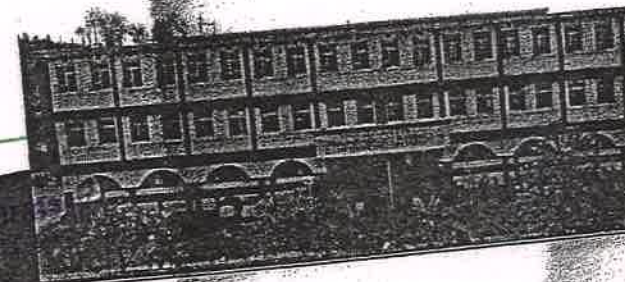
