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
#### World Pharmacist Day Awareness Walk

### NSS Foundation Day: A Day of Service and Commitment


















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#### **International Day of Yoga - 2024**

This year, as we reflect on the significance of water, let us also recognize the interconnectedness between water and climate.





#### National level Scientific Model-Hackathon


Competition Presentation of scientific models and ideas based on indigenous sources at the national level.


#### "A talk on journey as full bright scholar"






#### **Makar Sankranti-Traditional Day**
