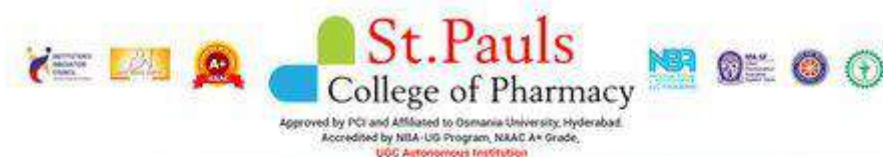
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St Pauls IIC cell MSME Cluster Workshop 10th march 2023

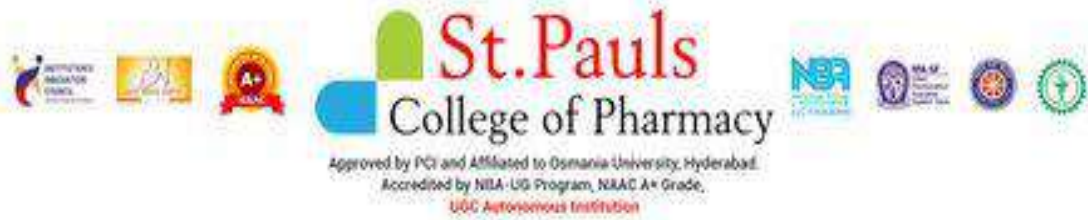

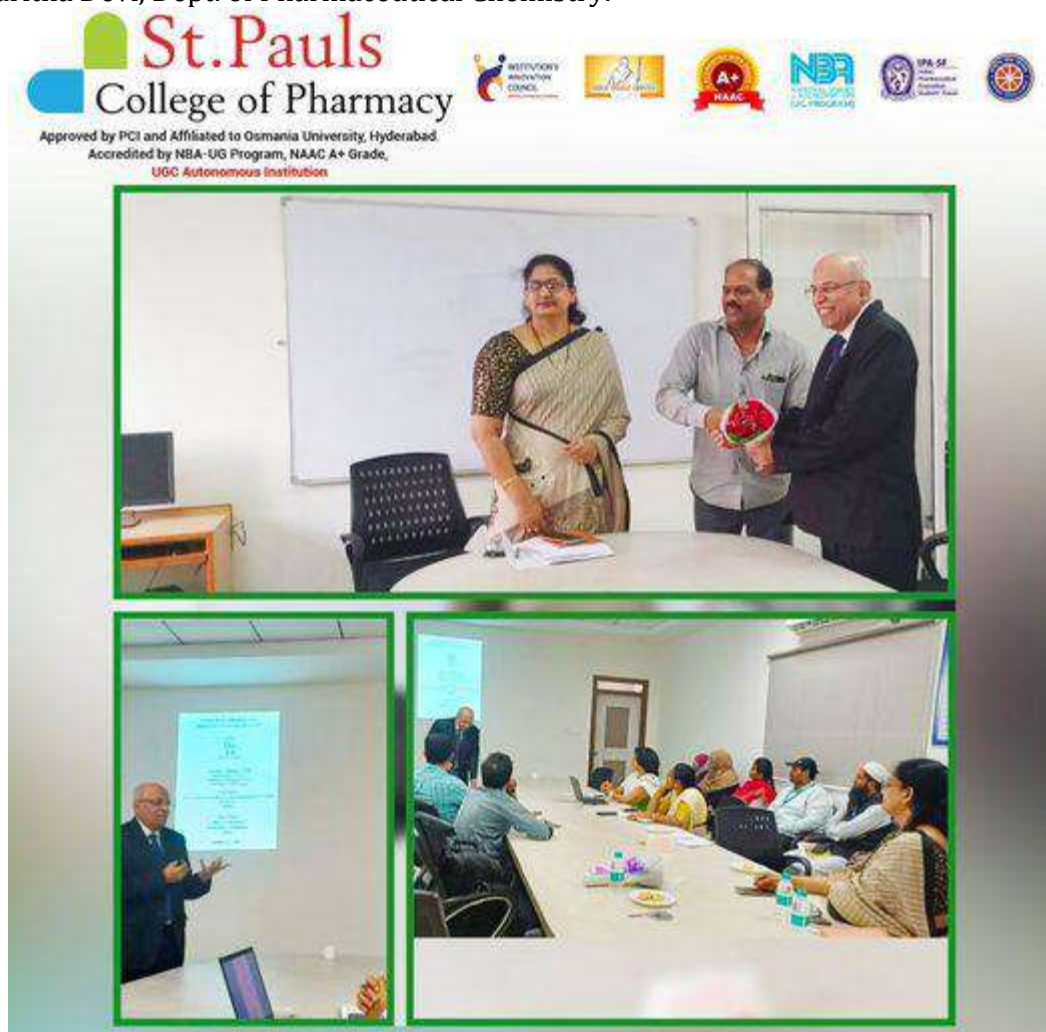
